1. Program Overview

- **Location:** GenkiJACS Fukuoka School
- **Period:** July 6, 2026 – July 24, 2026 (3-week program)
- **Age:** 14–17 years old
- **Japanese Level:** A0–A1 (*Students can join even if they cannot read Hiragana at the start*)
- **Capacity:** 60 students

2. Program Features

- Designed for students of similar age and level, creating a sense of community and making it easy to make friends.
- Content tailored to age and level (lessons, activities, support).
- **Japanese Lessons:** Small classes (**max 8 students***, conversation-focused)
- **Out Lessons:** Cultural learning and interaction outside the school
- **After Class:** Free time or optional activities
- **Day Trips & Overnight Trips** included

*Class arrangements may occasionally increase class size to 9 students

3. Accommodation & Meals

Accommodation Type: Homestay

- **Meals:** Breakfast & Dinner included

Default check-in: **Sunday, July 5**

Default check-out: **Sunday, July 26**

*If staying beyond these dates, an additional fee of **4,290 JPY per night** will apply

*Students may also request a Supervised Residence accommodation. This is subject to availability. Availability will be confirmed around April, and until then students will be on a waiting list. If no spaces are available, homestay arrangements will be made.

4. Fees

Total Fee: 550,000 JPY (**Lesson fee of 202,500 JPY is commissionable**)

Included:

Japanese lessons, Out Lessons, Day & Overnight Trips, Accommodation (Breakfast & Dinner), Lunch during trips, Airport pick-up/drop-off, Transportation card (19,500 JPY)

Not Included: Airfare, insurance, optional after-class activities

*Travel insurance can be applied for through the school at **250 JPY/day**. Insurance must cover the period from departure from the home country until leaving Japan. Dates can be adjusted after flight confirmation.

5. Cancellation & Refund Policy

Cancellations are allowed at any time. Refunds vary depending on the timing of cancellation:

Cancellation Date	Amount Charged
After application – 61 days before program (by May 5, 18:00 JST)	36,000 JPY
60–31 days before program (by June 4, 18:00 JST)	36,000 + 154,200 (30% remaining) = 190,200 JPY
30–15 days before program (by June 19, 18:00 JST)	36,000 + 257,000 (50% remaining) = 293,000 JPY

Cancellation Date

Less than 14 days before program

Amount Charged

36,000 + 514,000 (100% remaining)
= 550,000 JPY
